




### Conservation Measures

- Restricted gear types allowed in tributaries – no gill nets, traps, weirs unless authorized by Band
- Restricted fishing areas for gill nets to protect threatened stocks – Barriere/Louis
- Restricted gill net size to protect chinook
- Attempt to harvest a maximum of 10% of escapement

- **Dunn Lake Hatchery, Salmonid Enhance Program**  
Coho – wild & hatchery stocks  
Dunn, Louis & Lemieux Creeks  
Band membership complied with request not to fish these systems to allow stocks to re-build  
Provided awareness for the importance of non-fishing






### Barriere River







### Raft River
