GUIDE TO MAIN CONCEPTS AND TERMINOLOGY

The attached graphic represents the main features of the Fraser Salmon Roadmap Planning Group's (FSRPG) action plan to set the table for Department of Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) and First Nations to begin the negotiation of arrangements for the collaborative management of Fraser River salmon.

While the graphic includes a number of terms that are explained in the June 22-23, 2011 workshop, a brief written explanation of how the planning group is using these terms might help in follow-up communications.

- The **Fraser Salmon Engagement Framework** is a master document containing (or pointing to) all of the information needed for First Nations and DFO to get to the table, work out a collaborative management arrangement, implement an agreement and work with it over time
- all Engagement Framework content is bundled into **components**
- each component is associated with a **strategy** (objective, process, etc.) for building the component content, acting on it or linking it to other components
- **Agreement Template** refers to the template for building **collaborative management arrangements** and is the central **component** in the **Engagement Framework**
- A related **Engagement Framework component** consists of the **consultative management arrangements** DFO will-- in compliance with Government of Canada Directives--employ with First Nations communities and alliances not ready to negotiate collaborative management arrangements
- the FSRPG **action plans** are based on the logical sequencing of attention to component development toward the FSR process objective
