Why is it needed?

- Info. needs to be organized into manageable parts or components
 - *Components can be framed as issues or questions*
- Need to develop strategies to address the components

 - *Strategy: Roadmap participants id. protocols for reviewing, negotiating and ratifying a man. agreement*

Communications

- How do we communicate about this Engagement Framework?
 - *Strategy: Roadmap participants identify key messages*
