The Fraser Salmon Roadmap is an initiative between the Fraser Watershed and Marine Approach First Nations and Fisheries and Oceans Canada to explore the development of an arrangement for the joint management of Fraser salmon. The need for joint salmon management has long been a key issue in the evolving relationship between these two parties.

This Tier 1 session will provide an opportunity for First Nations to explore how a joint management arrangement with DFO should be structured to meet their interests.
