2. Area will be UFFCA geographic boundaries (Deadman Creek to Upper Fraser and tributaries)
3. Description of the productivity/ escapement trends and “salmon basket” available to Upper Fraser First Nations

Project Outline

4. Description and list of FN communities in geographical area to the extent possible (24 communities)
 - Preferred methods of harvest
5. Harvest Plan
 - DFO Communal license terms/conditions for the area (all salmon species)
 - Numerical Harvest target and summary by species/stock

Project Outline

6. A description of the current/planned/proposed DFO management regime for conservation, FSC and escapement by species/stock, as applicable
7. A comparison of the current/planned/proposed harvest plan, current DFO management regime and “salmon basket”
8. Recommendations to facilitate First Nations fisheries in achieving their harvest objectives
