

Summary of Points

- Interest in raising the AFE of 400,000 for more protection
 - Would like more information about the trade off, including the value to US, the cost to Canada and the impact on FN before providing advice
- Conservation is the priority for the treaty and would like that to be carried through in the negotiations
- Concerns about the appointment process for FNs Commissioners, and Panel members
 - A need to recognize what is outlined in UNDRIP

Summary of Points

- Tier 1 meetings – Premature to put together interests and advice right now and will have more articulated points to carry forward for negotiations in the fall.
- Need for a discussion between DFO/Government of Canada and Sumas First Nation regarding impact of Mission hydroacoustics on access to FSC and economic opportunities
- Need to build capacity for FNs regarding the technical components of the treaty

Summary of Points

- Need to do more engagement and more opportunities for FNs to provide input into the trade-offs Canada will take as the process moves forward
 - Ensure the process is iterative
